

## Emphasis in Communication Education (Pedagogy)

This emphasis is intended for students preparing to teach speech communication class in the secondary schools. All elective courses should be selected in conjunction with the academic advisor.

**Required courses:**

- COM 7000 Introduction to M.A. Studies in Communication (3 credits)
- COM 5030 Communication Ethics (3 credits)
- COM 6060 Teaching Communication at the Secondary Level (3 credits)
- COM 6070 Directing Forensics (3 credits)
- COM 7810 Seminar in Communication Education (3 credits)

**Choose one of the following Plans:**

**Plan A:**

- Elective courses sufficient to meet the minimum requirement of thirty-two credits.
- Eight credits of COM 8999 and an approved thesis

**Plan B:**

- Elective courses sufficient to meet the minimum requirement of thirty-two credits.
- Three credits of COM 7999 and an approved essay

**Plan C:** Elective classes sufficient to bring the total credit hours to at least 35.
